



BOOK RENTAL SCHEME

Thornleigh Educate Together is starting a **BOOK RENTAL SCHEME** for the school year 2010/2011 for all pupils in Junior Infants, Senior Infants, First Class and Second Class. This scheme enables parents to get all their child's books and stationary for the entire year at a reasonable rate.

HOW DOES IT OPERATE?

- Parents give their child's class teacher a once of payment of **€110 by June 18th 2010.**
This includes all books and stationary your child will require for the entire school year, arts and crafts, photocopying, report booklets, standardised tests etc. It will also support the schools development of computer and software resources, P.E. equipment and the library.
- The school bulk purchases all textbooks, workbooks, readers, copies and stationary for every individual who pays for the Rental Scheme.
- All books and stationary will be labelled with child's name and be in their classroom waiting for them on September 1st 2010.
- As it is a RENTAL SCHEME the books are the property of the school.
- Children in Junior Infants, Senior Infants, First Class and Second Class complete some work in their workbooks. These workbooks will be given to the children to take home at the end of the year. Readers, class novels etc will be kept in the school.
- If a book is lost and/or damaged it will be the responsibility of the parent to replace it.

MONEY REQUIRED

- Each parent has been given a small white envelope stapled to this letter with their child's name on it.
- It is asked that parents please enclose the **€110** in the envelope and give to their child's current teacher.
- The teacher will then write your child's name on the list and his/her books will be ordered.
- Junior Infant Parents for 2010/2011 have paid a **€50 deposit** to reserve their child's place in the school. Therefore the outstanding fee for JUNIOR INFANT PARENTS 2010/2011 ONLY is **€60.**
- A charge of **€4** is also requested for the Learn Together Programme to be placed in the same envelope.
